SUBJECT: Welcome Letter for Virtual Senior Transportation Operations Course

1. On behalf of the Transportation School Assistant Commandant, COL Timothy R. Zetterwall, and Director of the Transportation Management Training Department (TMTD), Mr. Trenton Lykes, we would like to welcome and congratulate all of you on attending the Senior Transportation Operations Course.
2. This Course focuses on integrating advanced applications in order to enable Sustainment/Transportation Corps Leaders to obtain a full understanding of global movement/distribution operations that link capabilities from strategic to tactical levels. Course will also mitigate the training/knowledge gap in our Operational Force units as a result of force redesign in multifunctional logistics capabilities as well as increasing the Army's capability for rapid expeditionary operations. Course will also concentrate on how to integrate movement/distribution capabilities with other services and/or nations in joint, combined or coalition environments.
3. **LOCATION:** This will be a **VIRTUAL** course and will be conducted through Army 365 Microsoft Teams. Army Teams 365 is the current platform for the virtual training and is **ONLY** accessible from a **DODIN (NIPRNet) or through Government Furnished Equipment (GFE) with a CISCO AnyConnect Virtual Private Network (VPN)**. A camera and microphone are required for taking this online course. If you are taking the class from home you must have an established IT support network to contact if you have TEAMS or computer issues. Instructors will not troubleshoot TEAMS or software issues. If you are having trouble establishing a TEAMS account please contact your G6 personnel or the Army Enterprise service Desk (AESD) at 1-866-335-2769.
4. **WHEN:** Training will commence at 0800 EST during the course.
5. **PRE-COURSE READING:**
Students are required to complete Pre-course reading in preparation for completing the day one practical exercise. Once a student is enrolled in the class with a reserve seat in ATRRS to attend STOC, they will receive a follow-on welcome letter from the instructor. The welcome letter will provide information of how to access blackboard to receive the pre-course reading. Please ensure your email address is correct in ATRRS.
